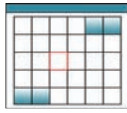

The Thanksgiving meal is made possible through the donations of businesses & churches. We plan to feed at least 600 people. Churches are asked to donate a meal of turkey, dressing, giblet gravy, and desserts to feed 20 people. We currently have approximately 9 meals promised, which will feed approximately 180 people. We depend on the churches and individuals to bring the requested meals, as they cannot be prepared on site. If a church, or individual is interested in supplying a meal, please contact the Baptist Center at 522-7066.



Thank you churches for your generous giving to the Christmas Backpack program this year. Because of your generosity 194 backpacks were delivered to our regional pick-up point in Paducah. The Kentucky goal is 5,000 backpacks. One half will be distributed directly to children living in poverty in Kentucky, while the other half will go to needy children in our partner Send City, Cincinnati. This initiative is a partnership with the North American Mission Board and Kentucky Woman's Missionary Union. These backpacks were filled with clothing, school supplies, hygiene items, toys, non-perishable food items, a copy of the Christmas Story leaflet, and a postcard to fill out to receive Bible lessons in the mail. Children from 2-14 years of age will be ministered to. What a great ministry to participate in, and you will be blessed by knowing that so many children will receive these gifts this Christmas.
