(Acts 17:6b) "... These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

I came across this verse in a study of the book of Acts some years back. Two questions came to my mind... "Is my life impacting the world at all? Am I influencing others for the cause of Jesus Christ?" Do you ever wonder if your life has had much impact on our world? Do you even care?

Julie and I attended the funeral being held at the church. When we pulled in, we saw the line to enter the church started at the parking lot. There must have been 300+ people there waiting, not counting those who had already passed thru. As we were waiting like others, some started sharing stories of meeting and knowing our friend. Story after story was simply a testimony of a life lived for Christ. Yes, the jokes, the laughs and the friendliness, but mostly about his Christian influence on them.

I share that story because the Apostle Paul and the disciples had such influence on the people of Thessalonica that even the enemies of the cross witnessed the impact they had on their world. How we choose to live our life is reflected on others around us as to what is REALLY important to us. We can make claims we care about the lost and the well-being of our community, but what we do we spend most of our time, talents and treasures doing?
