October is **Pastor Appreciation Month!**

Do you appreciate your pastor? Do you show/tell your pastor you appreciate him? You should!

In my 32 years of pastoring, I can still remember with fond memories the various ways in which some of my churches showed their appreciation for me and my family. Sometimes it was a celebration with a meal and a love offering, a money tree, or just a check from the church. One time my church paid for Julie & I to take a seminary class IN ISRA-EL! (That was above and beyond!) My point is each church did something to show their appreciation for our labor in the church. It always meant a great deal to me when they made the effort to say and show their love and appreciation.

Pastoring can be a lonely job at times. Few pastors have very many close friends. There is often a strain on the family when job requirements cause you to miss family events because of surgeries, trials and tragedies church members go through. It very easy to feel like you are out here all alone. No one seems to understand the stress, nor do they see the hours you spend in study to preach a 25–30-minute message. You have to remind yourself from time to time what the Apostle told the Galatian church in (Galatians 6:9) "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not."

One online dictionary described the word "appreciation" as the act of recognizing or understanding that something or someone is valuable or important. According to the Bible in the verse mentioned below... "... they are worthy of double the honor, especially those who labor to preach."

"Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine." (1 Timothy 5:17 KJV)

"The elders who are good leaders are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching." (1 Timothy 5:17 CSB)

Let me encourage you to take the time and initiative to make sure that your church shows your pastor how much you appreciate their labor of love in your church. Begin to make plans now, spread the word to others. Don't wait for someone else to take the first step.

- (1) Give a handwritten note or letter to your pastor.
- (2) Encourage a Love offering from church, or gift card for him.
- (3) Offer to babysit the kids so that he could have a date night with his wife.
- (4) Take the pastor and his family out for a meal.
- (5) Send the family to an overnight trip somewhere and pay for the expenses.
- (6) Arrange to have a family picture taken with a nice frame for them.




