"I Love that You Love the Way I Love You"

Maybe because of February and Valentine's Day, over the past few days, I have been quietly observing people's use of the word "Love." I've heard statements like... "I love you," "I love my new gun," (that was mine by the way) "We love our new bathroom," and lastly, on a TV show; "I love that you love the way I love you." It appears to me that the word love is

thrown around a great deal these days. Do we really love our spouse and family the same way we do our truck, job or new shoes? The dictionary defines the word LOVE, as "an intense feeling of deep affection, a profoundly tender and passionate affection for another person." In other words, love is simply based on a feeling someone may have for another, or even an object. Should we consider changing the meaning of the word LOVE?

Jesus told the disciples in John 13, "A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ve also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another." (vs. 34-35). This passage reveals a lesson Jesus was teaching his disciples while they were gathered in the upper room. The lesson mainly centered around the action of love than the emotion. This same truth is taught in 1 John 3:14, "We know that we have passed from death unto life. because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death." A little further down in verse 18 he says, "... let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth." Real love is an action word. Love brings a person to a responsibility to reveal that love for another. Again in 1 John 4:19 "We love him, because he first loved us." God revealed his love for us through the birth, life, sacrificial death and the resurrection of His Son Jesus Christ.

Over the next few months, we are preparing to take the Gospel of Jesus Christ to every home in Trigg County. This will be a monumental effort to share the gospel to over 14,000, people, in over 7,000, different homes. However, the bible says, "How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?" (Rom. 10:14). I simply believe that Jesus said if we love him and if we love our friends and neighbors, and want to see them come to know the Lord... we will share the gospel... By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another."
