A Year Without Fear

Happy New Year to everyone! My thought for this month is based on a Bible study, Bro. Ronnie Sivells, my pastor (even though he claims I'm not there enough to call him my pastor). Anyway, Bro. Ronnie spoke a few Wednesday nights ago about "FEAR." While I was listening to him talk about the angel telling Zacharias "Not to fear" Luke 1:13, Mary "Not to fear" Luke 1:30 and the Shepherds "Not to fear" in Luke 2:10, my mind was taken back to a message from Dr. Adrian Rogers on fear. His title (I think) was "A Year Without Fear."

Could you imagine a year without fear? An entire year, a new year, entered without any fear whatso-ever! Paul told Timothy in 1 Tim. 1:7 "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind."

He said, "The boilers on this ship are very weak and may explode at any moment." He said, "Also, the ship is very old, and she's taking on water." So, he said, "To be very honest with you, we may have an explosion, or we may sink." He said, "We may go up, or we may go down, but at any rate, we are going on." And that's the way we are as we face this new year dear friend. Jesus may come, we may go up. We may die, and go down and then up, but at any rate we are going on. Isn't that true. We're going on. We're facing a brand-new year, and we don't know what it's going to bring.

Some folks make resolutions about weight or something health-wise for the new year. I read the other day a truth that I need to learn, "People are so worried about what they eat between Christmas and the New Year, but they really should be worried about what they eat between the New Year and Christmas." 
