- ⇒ 293 meals were prepared & delivered across the county

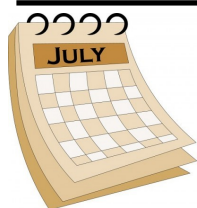


Little River will again be a collection point for the KBC Christmas Backpack project.
