What A Difference You've Made in My Life

Some of you may remember the song made popular by country singer Ronnie Milsap called, “*What a difference you’ve made in my life.*” Milsap released the song in November of 1977, and it very quickly became a number one hit for him. However, did you know that the composer/writer of the song, a man named Archie Jordan, intended for the song to be a Christian single about the difference the Lord had made in his life? The song was first recorded by Christian artist Amy Grant, released mostly in Christian stores, reaching only to #5. Ronnie Milsap’s version is still widely know even today.

The truth is... God has made a difference in the lives of a great many people, including myself. **God is a difference making God!** The Bible is a difference making Book! Abraham made a difference. Joseph made a difference. Moses, Joshua, Nehemiah and Daniel, John, Peter, James and John, all made a difference. In later part of 1735, a ship made its way to the New World from England.
