As if the sickness is not bad enough, I have had several friends, including Bro. Norman Cotton, pastor of Ponderosa Baptist Church, who have experienced the passing of their mother in these past few weeks. While all those deaths are tragic, the death of a mother as we prepare for May and Mother's Day brought some thoughts to my mind I wanted to share with you.

The late TV comedian Milton Berle said, "If evolution really works, how come mothers only have two hands?" It is true, however, that the role of mother is much more than what is seen on the surface. It's not just her work that is often praised, it's also her words; her advice.

With Mother's Day just around the corner, my thoughts were taken back to my mother's advice of my years growing up.
