The Signs of the Times

"And in the morning, It will be foul weather today: for the sky is red and lowring. O ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not discern the signs of the times?" **Matthew 16:3**

Jesus became critical of the Pharisees because they could not discern the signs of the times in their day in Matt. 16:3. Yet, our world is no clearer today in their understanding than before. America is growing increasingly hostile toward biblical Christianity. The Bible has ceased to be America's moral compass, and for those who choose to hold to biblical principles; your accused of being intolerant at best and lawbreakers at worst.

Over the last few years, a growing number of churches, businesses, and individuals have come under legal attack for standing on their biblical beliefs and principles. Many, if not most of these attacks have come about when "believing" Christians have resisted the declining view of biblical sexual—moral standards in the U.S.

Many studies show that America's biblical foundation began to erode in the post-World War II prosperity which resulted in the protest culture of the 1960s. The resulting freedoms have brought about a philosophy of "If it feels good, do it."

A Pew Research poll reported that Christianity is declining sharply in America. In 2014 about 70% of American adults identified as Christians, by 2018-19 that number had dropped to 65%. But could these figures be misleading? Because, according to a study by sociologists C. Kirk Hadaway and Penny Long Marler published in The Journal for the Scientific Study of Religion, less than twenty percent of Americans regularly attend church on a weekly basis. One might feel that these statistics give a better indication of actual decline in Christian commitment.

Dr. Paul Nyquist, the president of Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, writes, "Get ready. An exciting, yet terrifying era is beginning for American believers. As cultural changes sweep our country, we'll soon be challenged to live out what the Bible says about confronting and responding to persecution."
