## ***A Famine in The Land***

*Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD: (Amos 8:11)*

Most of us have never really known a physical famine. Maybe there has been a time when you were hungry and there was nothing in the house to eat, but to go extended days without food, few of us have experienced. However, our world has and is experiencing a famine spoken of in Amos.

We are not a strong militarily as we used to be in this nation, but we are still the world’s lone superpower. Yet, in the midst of our peace, our prosperity and our endless pursuit of personal happiness, we are in the midst of a spiritual drought, and we do not even recognize it.

May our community recognize the need for God’s word to be proclaimed in our churches, homes and communities.
